HEAD COACH TINA KIHARA

Tina Kihara begins her first year as golf coach at Christopher Newport.

Kihara, a native of Miami, Florida, will continue as the Head Teaching Golf Professional at Williamsburg National Golf Club, a position she has held since March.

"We are very excited to add Tina to our staff," Woollum said. "Her experiences in the world of golf are immense and she will bring her outstanding teaching ability to our program."

Kihara has more than twenty years of teaching and training experience, and has also designed, developed and implemented golf programs for juniors, men and women.

"My goal for CNU is to bring them to a championship level," Kihara said. "With the support given by Williamsburg National Golf Club, the team has a tremendous place to call home. We have the perfect training facility, and that is where it all begins."

Kihara becomes the ninth head coach in the 38-year history of the golf program. She takes over from Chris Jones, who served as the interim coach of the program last season.



LAST SEASON IN REVIEW

The 2006-2007 season was another solid year by CNU standards. The Captains finished third out of the seven schools in the tough USA South's Conference Championships.

The tournament was limited to just one round due to heavy rains. Andrew Geary and Kyle Schaffner each fired rounds of 75 and finished in a tie for sixth place. Matt Hopkins finished with a 76 and tied for eighth, while Eric Smialek (80) and John Corbin (81) finished 17th and 18th, respectively.

Hopkins and Corbin were both named Second Team All-USA South for their performances in the spring season.

It was an up and down spring for the Captains, as they began the spring season with a fifth place tie at the Barton Intercollegiate and followed that up with a 15th place finish at the Jekyll Island Intercollegiate and a 15th place finish after two days of the Camp Lejeune Intercollegiate. CNU tied for fifth at the Camp Lejeune Gold Tournament. The team's final tune-up before the conference championships was a 13th place finish at the Emory Invitational.

Hopkins finished his CNU career by averaging 75.2 strokes per round. He had several solid individual round performances, including a 66 on day two of the Camp Lejeune Intercollegiate. He had just one round in the 80's. He finished his career with two rounds of 66, the lowest in program history.

Sean Cassidy played in six rounds in the spring and finished with a stroke average of 75. His 67 on day two of the Camp Lejeune Intercollegiate was the second best round ever in school history.

In the fall, the Captains played in four tournaments and finished no lower than 10th place at any of them. The team's best finish was third at the Virginia State Intercollegiate. They also had a fifth place finish at the Ted Keller Invitational, seventh at the Tom O'Briant Memorial and a 10th place finish at the Greensboro College Invitational.

For the year, Geary played in 11 rounds and finished with an average of 75.5. Hopkins totaled 19 rounds and finished with a 75.6 stroke average. Corbin played 17 total rounds and averaged 77.1. Malcolm Craig played 8 rounds and finished with a 78.1 while Smialek finished the year playing 18 rounds and averaged 78.7.

PREVIEW OF 2007-2008

The Captains will have one of the youngest teams in CNU history in 2008.

This year's squad boasts no seniors, just one junior and one sophomore plus five freshmen.

Sean Cassidy and Malcolm Craig return and will be looked upon as leaders both on and off the course.

Combine those two returners with newcomers Ian Brennan, Andrew Deitrick, Ben Edwards, Chris Olson and Matt Wagner, and this year's team, could pose some problems for opposing teams.

Coach Kihara's experience of being a professional golfer will come in handy, as she will push them to be the best that they can be. She's a true believer in hard work and a little luck, but she believes in her players.

In her eyes, her team is very equal and she does not see one being better than another. They are all dedicated and practice hard.

Christopher Newport will once again play in several of the toughest tournaments around the area. They began their season by winning the Virginia Wesleyan Tournament and then heading to Jekyll Island, GA to play in the Jekyll Island Intercollegiate, Match 21-23.

After a few days off, the Captains will head to Jacksonville, NC to play in the prestigious Marine Corps Intercollegiate held at Camp Lejeune March 28-30.

The very next week, CNU will return to Georgia to play in the Emory Spring Invitational April 7-8 and finish up with the Apprentice Tournament, April 14-15, before heading to Burlington, NC for the USA South Championship. The conference tournament this year has expanded from a two-day event to a three-day tournament.

Few, if any, Division III schools have had the overall success of the Christopher Newport athletic program.

Through the end of the 2006-07 season, CNU teams had won 12 national championships, either won or shared 150 conference titles and have produced an amazing number of individual accomplishments.

CNU athletes have won All-America recognition an amazing 516 times and have captured 64 individual national championships.

In the USA South Athletic Conference, CNU has won ten consecutive President's Cups and 16 of the last 24. Statewide, in Virginia, Christopher Newport has had the best win-loss record of any school in the state for six of the last ten years.

Nationally, CNU teams have made 59 NCAA appearances since 1982, not counting hundreds of individuals in track, cross country and golf.

Fast Facts

Christopher Newport University is a small, selective public university. It offers baccalaureate programs through its College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and the Joseph W. Luter, III School of Business, which earned international accreditation in 2005 by the world's top business accrediting organization – the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business. The University also offers a five-year bachelor's to masters program in teaching and graduate programs in applied physics and computer science and environmental science.

Location

CNU's 260-acre campus is located in Newport News, Va., two and a half hours south of Washington, D.C., less than an hour from Williamsburg and Virginia Beach, and just a few blocks from where the tidal James River flows into the Chesapeake Bay.

Student Profile

Forty-five percent of CNU's 4,800 students are male; 55 percent are female. Students come to CNU from every region in Virginia, 32 other states, and several foreign nations. The average high school GPA is 3.4 (on a 4.0 scale). The average SAT score is 1165 (critical reading and math sections).

History

Founded in 1960 as a two-year branch of the College of William and Mary, CNU became independent in 1977 and gained university status in 1991. Today, CNU is the youngest comprehensive university in the Commonwealth.

Class Size

With an average class size of 25 students, CNU has much smaller classes than most state universities. More than 90 percent of classes are seminars, and no classes are taught by graduate teaching assistants.

Facilities

With a \$400 million building campaign nearly complete, CNU's campus is bursting with new buildings and

improvements. Recent additions include state-of-the-art residential facilities, a \$16 million sports and convocation center, the new Ferguson Center for the Arts, and residential facility restaurants and stores. Opening in fall 2006 is a state-of-the-art student union; and an expansion project that will double the size of CNU's library is scheduled for completion in fall 2007.

Ferguson Center for the Arts

The \$60 million Ferguson Center for the Arts is the crowning jewel of Christopher Newport University. Teaching and learning are celebrated in the 1,700-seat Concert Hall, 440-seat Music and Theatre Hall, 200-seat Studio Theatre, classrooms, sound-isolated music practice spaces, rehearsal halls, dance studios, costume shops, lighting labs and set design studios. The Center's inaugural season, which began in September 2005, included world-class classical, pop, Broadway and dance performances, attracting more than 120,000 patrons and ticket revenue in excess of \$3.2 million.

Athletics

CNU athletes compete in 21 NCAA sports, including football, lacrosse and sailing. The University ranks fifth nationally in NCAA Division III Team Championships, and the school has produced 500 All-Americans.

Residence Halls

Nearly 3,000 students are housed in the University's state-of-the-art residential facilities that include four new resi-

dence halls and two new apartment complexes that win raves from students and parents, as well as architectural awards. New residential living includes CNU Village, a unique mixed-use development on campus that houses restaurants and stores that serve the entire community as well as students, faculty and staff. Every residential room has high-speed Internet, basic satellite cable TV, digital local phone service, 24-hour security, and electronic room access. All rooms are equipped with a microwave and mini-refrigerator or have kitchen access.

Faculty

Eighty-five percent of CNU's 932 faculty members hold the Ph.D. or highest degree in their fields. Fifty-five new faculty members have been added since 2003.

Cost

For in-state, full-time undergraduates, tuition and fees are \$6,460, and room and board is \$8,100. Christopher Newport University offers a variety of financial aid programs to help students and their parents pay for college; 43 percent of students receive some form of aid.

Campus Life

CNU's 100 clubs and organizations include academic organizations, fraternities and sororities, and special-interest groups. From Altered Xpressionz to Vibes of Our Vernacular, students are sure to find something to spark their interests.



Outstanding teaching with a strong commitment to undergraduate education and the liberal studies core are the hallmarks of Christopher Newport University. A dramatic transformation spanning the past decade has placed it among the United States' pre-eminent liberal arts universities. As the youngest university in the Commonwealth of Virginia's excellent system of higher education, CNU is getting better, not bigger.

CNU offers an unbeatable combination of great teaching, small classes and a commitment to placing students first, which means that the quality of teaching, advising and student life is the University's first concern. Classes average only 25 students, and are taught by faculty members – 85 percent of which hold a doctorate or the highest degree in their field – not teaching assistants. These scholars desire to engage and challenge students inside and outside the classroom and are committed to playing an active role in campus life.
